

# Advice for Foreign Domestic Helpers, Employers and Employment Agencies to cope with the COVID-19 pandemic



## Foreign Domestic Helpers (FDHs)

- Comply with the regulations on prohibition of group gatherings and mask-wearing.
- Stay home for rest on rest days/holidays as far as possible. Avoid staying in crowded places (including in boarding facilities), sharing meals and having meal gatherings when going out.



## FDH Employers

- Maintain social distancing and avoid social gatherings at home as far as possible.
- Discuss rest day arrangements with FDHs.
- Be considerate and show understanding of FDHs' needs.



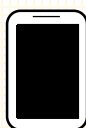
## Employment Agencies

- Not to arrange FDHs to gather in boarding facilities.
- Comply with the health advice on personal hygiene and social distancing issued by the Centre for Health Protection, keep the boarding facilities clean and maintain good environmental hygiene.
- Keep a register of FDHs who have stayed in or visited boarding facilities for contact tracing of possible confirmed cases.
- Remind FDHs staying in boarding facilities to pay attention to personal hygiene and maintain social distancing.
